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From the Desk of the Fire Marshal

It is a lot easier to climb a mountain if you have someone beside you helping to carry the load. In my case, I have a great staff that burdens most of the load. From the training of students, faculty and staff, to review and inspection of construction projects and the installation and maintenance of fire extinguisher. My staff works tirelessly to insure the safety of everyone connected with the University of Kentucky.

The Assistant Fire Marshal, Jason Ellis leads the effort in training and inspections. Over 20,000 students, faculty and staff received training in 2014. Jason serves on the NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) 45 Technical Committee and the ICC/IFC (International Code Council/International Fire Council). In both cases Jason is the only representative of colleges and universities in the nation. He has represented the University of Kentucky and instructed at CSHEMA, NFPA, Campus Fire Safety and Campus Fire seminars. Jason has researched and applied for grants for the UK AED program in junction with OHS. Representing the Fire Marshal's office at multiple Athletic, SAB and Greek events. Daily leading the effort in facility inspections and training.

The review and inspections of construction projects is under the control of Plan Reviewer, Brandon Ernest. Brandon has completely overhauled the entire process. In the past the Plan Reviewers office resembled a paper storage facility. Construction plans stuffed everywhere. Brandon has the process completely paperless. All projects are now submitted via disk or on-line. Brandon is on target to receive his Level III Plan Reviewer Certification. The review process has been stream lined and turnaround time on project approval has never been faster. UK is expanding at an unbelievable pace and Brandon has been able to stay on top of every project.

Fire Extinguisher training, inspection and maintenance is led by Robert Harrison. Robert is the newest member of the team. In less than a year Robert has taken a program in a mess to a model program. All inspections are up to date and his training classes are receiving compliments. As one of the most valued tools, the Mobile Burn Unit is under Robert's control. It is always ready with a few days' notice.

We have not reached the top, but with my staff it will be an easier climb than others!

- (1) **Fire Alarm System-**Consist of a fire alarm control panel, pull stations, smoke detectors and interconnection with any required suppression system. All fire alarm systems are monitored and notify the required personnel upon activation.
- (2) **Sprinkler System**-Water fire suppression systems. Upon activation, sounds an alarm in the facility affected and sends a signal to the monitoring company. The monitoring company notifies the required personnel.
- (3) Smoke Detectors-Smoke sensing devices installed in required locations. Sounds a local alarm in the facility affected

Fire Drills

Each on-campus housing facility is required to have fire drills in accordance with the Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs life safety policy 08052010.pdf.

Part II, Section D, of the policy requires the following:

- I. Two fire drills shall be conducted during the Fall Semester. The first drill shall be an announced walk-through drill. The second drill shall be unannounced.
- 2. One unannounced drill shall be conducted during the Spring Semester
- 3. All fire drills shall be reported to the Office of the University Fire Marshal via the on-line fire drill report http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/fire/drill.html within 48 hours of the event.
- 4. The fire alarm shall be utilized for each drill.
- 5. The Office of Residence Life shall schedule fire drills.

Part III, Section B, has all the same requirements as stated in Part II, Section D, with the exception being that the Dean of Students Office will schedule the drills for the on-campus Fraternities and Sororities.

Each facility listed on the Life Safety Equipment in Student Housing Facilities List (pages 4-5) is required to have fire drills. A record of each drill is kept on file in the Office of the University Fire Marshal.

For the year 2014, all Residence Halls, Apartments, Sororities, and Fraternities completed the required drills.



Electrical Appliances, Smoking and Open Flames

The University Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing Policy http://ehs.uky/edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs life safety policy 08052010.pdf contains information on electrical appliances, smoking and open flames.

Part I, Section E, is related to a student's room. In this section, students are informed that smoking is not permitted in any University building. Candles and incense (open flames) are not permitted in student housing.

Part I, Section F, is related to electrical issues. This section informs students that extension cords and multi-plug adaptors are not permitted in University housing, as well as how electrical equipment is to be maintained.

Section G, is related to appliances. This section bans the use of space heaters and halogen lamps. Microwave ovens and toasters are permitted as long as sufficient electrical current is available. All other cooking devices shall be located in a kitchen.

Evacuation Policy

The University has a **mandatory evacuation policy**

http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/fire/evacuation.html. All students, faculty and staff are required to immediately evacuate in the event of a fire alarm. This policy applies to all buildings at any time.The only exception to this policy is in patient related areas. Such as the University Hospitals.

Any student that violates the evacuation policy is subject to disciplinary actions by the Dean of Students Office.

Utilizing the Building Emergency Action Plan (BEAP) the Hall Directors and Resident Advisors train occupants on the procedures for evacuation.

Procedures include but are not limited to:

- 1. When the alarm sounds start evacuating immediately.
- 2. Make sure the fire is not outside your door.
- 3. Never go toward the smoke (find another way out).
- 4. Go to your assigned meeting location.
- 5. If you are trapped by the fire call 911.
- 6. Report anyone that did not evacuate to your Resident Advisor or Hall Director.

Each on-campus housing facility is required to have fire drills in accordance with the Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing http://ehs.ukv.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs life safety policy 08052010.pdf.

Part II, Section D, of the policy requires the following:

- 1. Two fire drills shall be conducted during the Fall Semester. The first drill shall be an announced walk-through drill. The second drill shall be unannounced.
- 2. One unannounced drill shall be conducted during the Spring Semester
- 3. All fire drills shall be reported to the Office of the University Fire Marshal via the on-line fire drill report http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/fire/drill.html within 48 hours of the event.
- 4. The fire alarm shall be utilized for each drill.
- 5. The Office of Residence Life shall schedule fire drills.

Part III, Section B, has all the same requirements as stated in Part II, Section D, with the exception being that the Dean of Students Office will schedule the drills for the on-campus Fraternities and Sororities.

Each facility listed on the Life Safety Equipment in Student Housing Facilities List (pages 2-4) is required to have fire drills. A record of each drill is kept on file in the Office of the University Fire Marshal.

For the year 2011, all Residence Halls, Apartments, Sororities, and Fraternities completed the required drills.

Education and Training

All occupants living in on-campus housing are required to have fire/life safety training as outlined in the Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Housing

http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs life policy 08052010.pdf. All fire/life safety training is required to be conducted or approved by the Office of the University Fire Marshal.

All Hall Directors and Resident Advisors are required to have fire and life safety training prior to students moving into the residence halls. Resident Advisors are required to complete a fire safety class within the first few weeks of each new school year.

The President or designee of each Greek Organization is to ensure that all occupants read and understand the fire/life safety policy and to schedule a fire/life safety class within the first two weeks of each semester.

Throughout the month of September, the Office of the University Fire Marshal and the Lexington Fire Department conduct training and sessions throughout the University. Dorm room burn simulation, T-shirt give away, fire extinguisher training and a smoke tent are set up at various locations.

In 2014 this office taught 325 classes and resulted in over 20,123 students receiving training in fire and life safety.

Students in randomly selected residence halls have fire drills using theatrical smoke. These drills provide students an opportunity to gain the understanding of what it is like in a real fire situation.

Who Needs to Know

All University buildings have fire alarm systems that are monitored by a central station. When an alarm is activated, the central station automatically notifies the Lexington Fire Department and the University Police Department (UKPD). Calling 911 is recommended after you have evacuated the building.

The UKPD notifies all essential personnel via the RAVE system (cell phone, text and email). Students only need to report a fire to the UKPD via 911.


Looking Toward the Future
