## **Instructions for New Radiation Workers Form**

All individuals at UK proposing to work with x-ray must, as per federal and state regulations, receive Beginning and On-Site safety training before starting as a radiation worker. Weekly training sessions are available through the Radiation Safety Office, 102 Animal Pathology. Call the Office at 3-6777 to attend a session or schedule a time.

The training is in two parts. The first part is On-Site Training which must be provided by the Authorized User or unit supervisor at the individual's place of work. A completed **On-Site X-ray Safety Training Form** must provide to the individual as evidence of receiving this part of the training. Then contact the Radiation Safety Office for the second part, the Beginning X-ray Safety Training. The individual must bring a copy of the signed On-Site training form and a completed, signed **Radiation Worker Registration Form** to the second part. No one will be admitted without both of these forms.

This Initial and On-Site training enables an individual to begin as a radiation worker.

Specific x-ray safety (diagnostic, veterinary, dental, research) courses will be scheduled as needed.
